While small projects do not typically garner the same amount of excitement or attention as their larger counterparts, they are nonetheless critical to the success of any organization. Whether it is a new instrument, or equipment install, or a process change, most organizations are executing a significant number of these projects annually. This presentation will focus on identifying and harnessing critical control points in the planning and execution of small projects (<\$5MM) and will summarize a few key concepts and strategies ProPharma Group employs in order to drive each project to a successful completion.

Jim Kolbet is the Director of Program Management for ProPharma Group. ProPharma Group's 400+ colleagues provide consulting and medical information services to GMP clients on 6 continents. In his current role, Jim develops and executes ProPharma Group strategy in support of client Technology Transfers, Identification of Contract Manufacturers and Project Management. **Brady Cole, VP Commercial Operations, ABEC**

ABEC's Integrated Solutions approach addresses the chronic communication and accountability challenges so many projects face. The approach can reduce the risk of the budget misses that are common in the industry. ABEC will discuss how they developed this unique concept, which combines all the elements of the bulk bioprocess - upstream, downstream, and Clean Utilities - into a single scope of supply, providing a fixed price for the entire bulk process prior to project approval for construction.

Brady Cole has over 20 years of technical and commercial experience in high technology industries. He began his career developing plasma deposition and etch processes for advanced microelectronics. He later moved on to product management roles in the semiconductor capital equipment industry at Mattson Technology and MKS Instruments. Since joining ABEC in 2002, Brady has held leadership positions in sales and product management. In 2012 he established ABEC's China business unit, and he currently oversees global sales, marketing, and applications.
